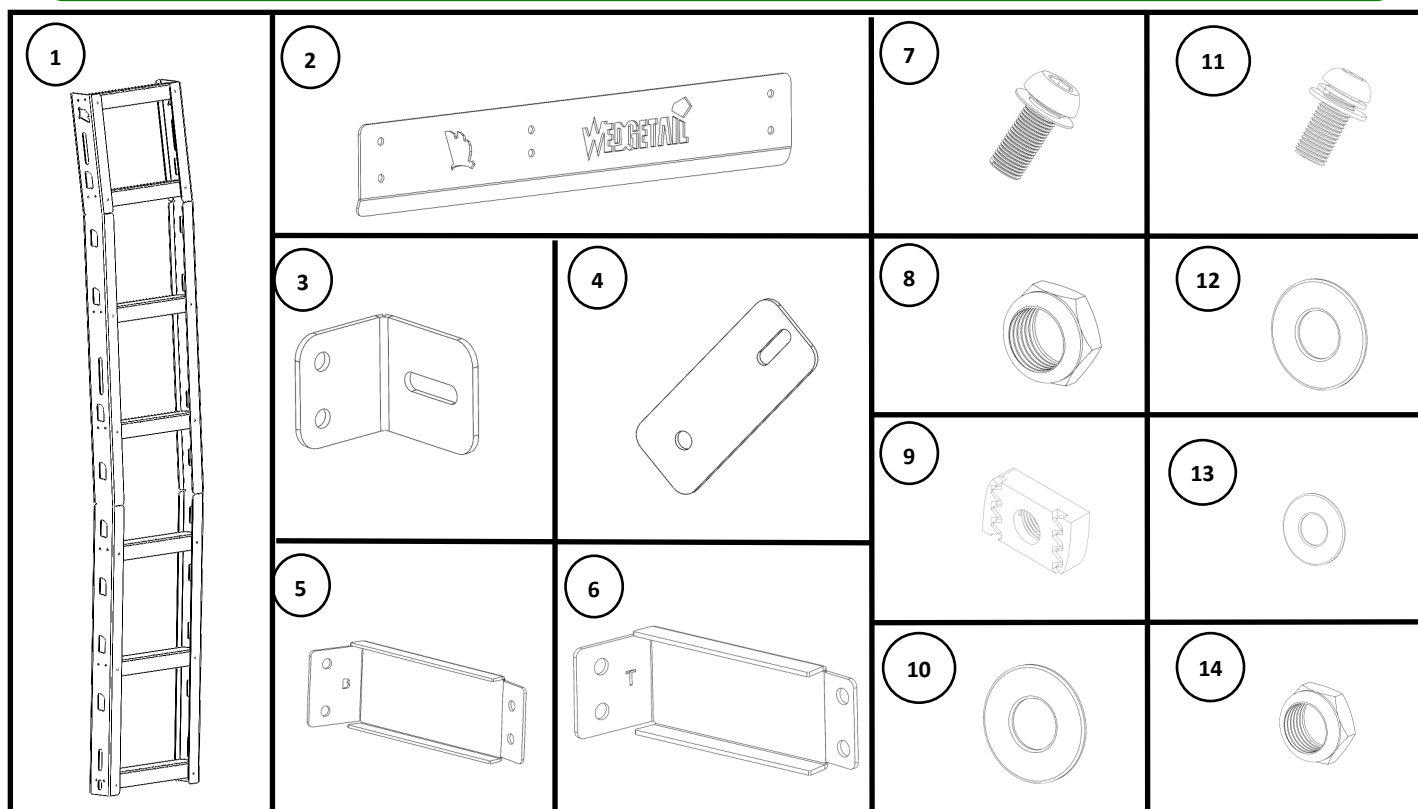

- Plastic scraper
- Drill bit

- Remove inner door trim
- Mount top and bottom hinge mounts loosely to the hinges using M10 bolt and channel nuts on inside of hinge

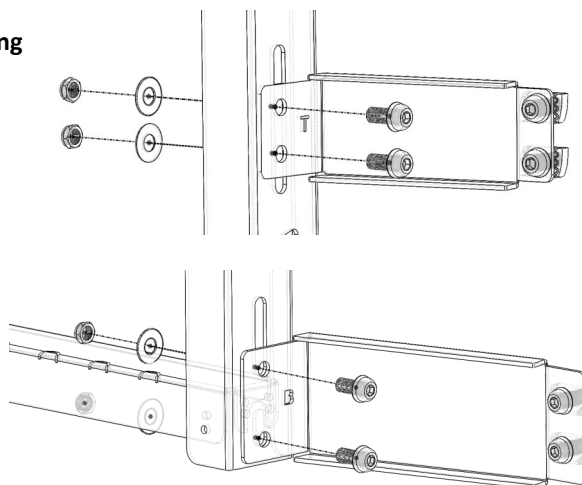

- Mount the ladder to the hinge brackets using M10 bolts, washers and nylon nuts.
- Tighten all bolts from step 1 and 2

Item 1	Wedgetail Ladder
Item 6	10 MM Nyloc Nut
Item 7	M10 Dacro Sems Dome Head Bolt 25mm
Item 9	10mm Flat Washer

- Lining up the side of the ladder hold right angled brackets up on the door skin with the bottom edge lining up with the door seem at top and bottom mounts, mark holes to be drilled with a marking pen.

*** Some models may need to have a badge removed these are only held in place with double sided tape so using a plastic scraper remove then clean off any leftover tape.**

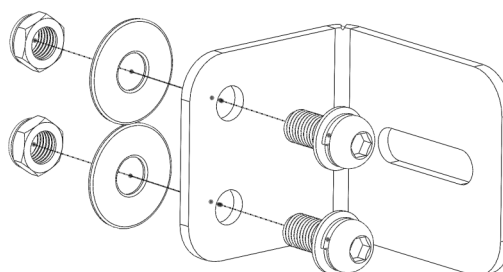

- Remove the ladder off the hinge brackets and set aside.
- Drill all 4x holes. Using the lower Wedgetail mount sit bolts in centre holes and mark outside holes in end of the bracket. Before drilling check distance of holes from door seem (should be 15mm to centre hole) then when all lined up drill all holes.
- Deburr and paint all exposed bare metal, then with natural cure silicon cover all holes.

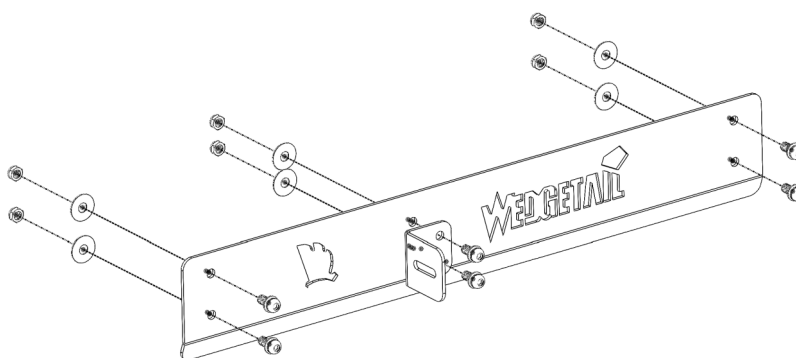

- Top mount use 2x M8 bolts large M8 flat washer and nyloc nuts bolt in place and tighten.

Item 2	Wedgetail Outer Floor Brace
Item 3	Wedgetail Right Angled Support Plate
Item 11	M8 x22 Dacro Black
Item 12	M8 Large Flat Washer
Item 14	M8 Nyloc Nut

- The lower mount using 6x M8 bolts large M8 washers and Nyloc nuts



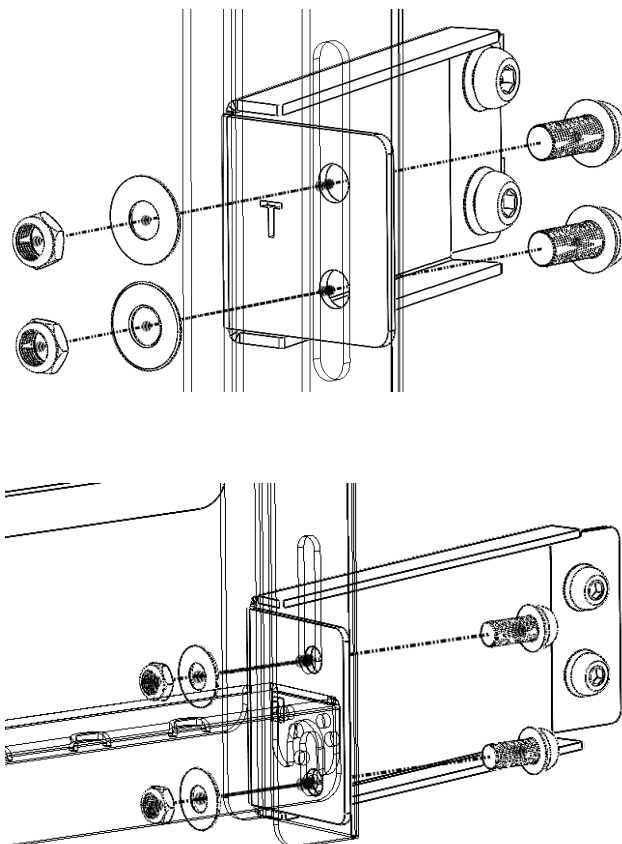
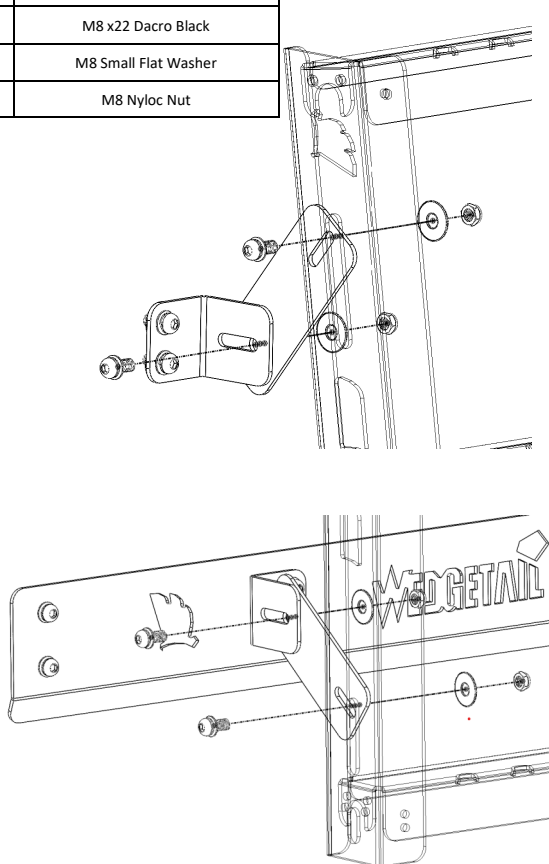
- Put all bolts through lower mounting plate and through the right-angled bracket to the middle holes loosely
- When all bolts are started go back over and tighten.
- Clean off any silicon coming out from around the mounts.

- Re-mount ladder to hinge brackets and using 2x flat plates supplied bolt from brackets mounted to door to the slots in the ladder. When tightening these make sure to line up the ladder with the door skin and then tighten in place.

- Recommended using a Sikka flex adhesive sealant on all inner frames to the door skin. The factory adhesive is known as being weak and this will stop rattles later and will give both top and bottom mounts more strength.
- Reinstall door trim
